Passport Program Rules

1. Passports are not valid during special events.
2. Passports are not valid for organized groups (including schools).
3. Residents outside of Santa Barbara County participate at each institutions discretion.
4. This K-6 grade Passport provides FREE ADMISSION to the institutions (listed on page three) for one child and one companion 17 or older. Please see page three institution's listing for specific visit dates and times.
5. The Passport program runs through April 13, 2012.
6. Children who collect 8 stamps in their Passport earn a FREE T-shirt.
7. To receive a stamp at each institution, students must complete a special activity.
8. After collecting 8 stamps, children can order their FREE T-shirt by giving their name, phone number, and T-shirt size to a representative at the 8th institution.
